



Policies for Reopening Safely!

Effective March 28th, 2021, and continuing indefinitely, Glendale Church will be reopening its doors for in-person services. We are following all LA County Public Health guidelines for conducting indoor services. Below is a list of steps we are taking to mitigate the risk that COVID-19 might be spread during one of our services.

- Parking will only be available in Lot B and Lot C. Lot A (off Spazier) will be reserved for volunteers, staff, and ADA entrance only.
- Attendance will be limited to 25% of our auditorium capacity per service.
- An overflow room will be provided at 25% capacity with a closed circuit video feed of the service for anyone who wishes to stay further distanced
- All attendees must register for seats via the Church Center app, which can be downloaded via your phones app store. This is so we may plan the seating to accommodate families together
- Please use the restroom before arriving. Restrooms will be closed except for emergencies
- There will be no Children's Church. The nursery will be open for emergency, single-household use
- Attendees will be screened at the door with a short questionnaire and non-contact temperature check
- All attendees must wear a mask over their nose and mouth at all times while inside the facility. Masks will be provided as needed for those who do not bring their own.
- Anyone exhibiting signs of fever or respiratory distress will be asked to attend our online campus
- All persons entering the facility must leave a name and contact information so that we may contact you in case someone who attended begins exhibiting symptoms later in the week
- Ushers will seat you. Once seated, all persons will be asked to remain seated for the duration of the service
